NHS Resolution (NHSR) manages clinical negligence and other claims against the NHS in England. NHSR has provided the following information:

The total cost of clinical negligence claims in the financial year 2020/21 was £2,209.3 million.

The table below shows the breakdown of these costs:

Damages Paid to Claimants	£1609.8m
Claimant Legal Costs	£448.1m
NHS Legal Costs	£151.4m
TOTAL	£2209.3m
